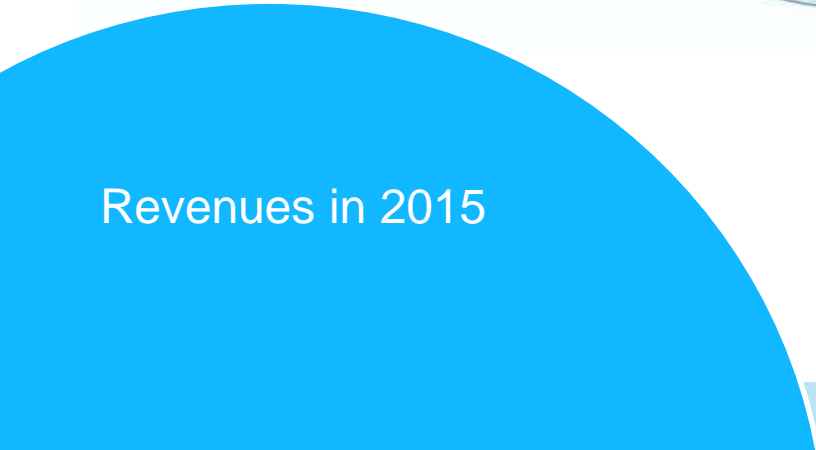

- Headquarters in Frankfurt, Germany



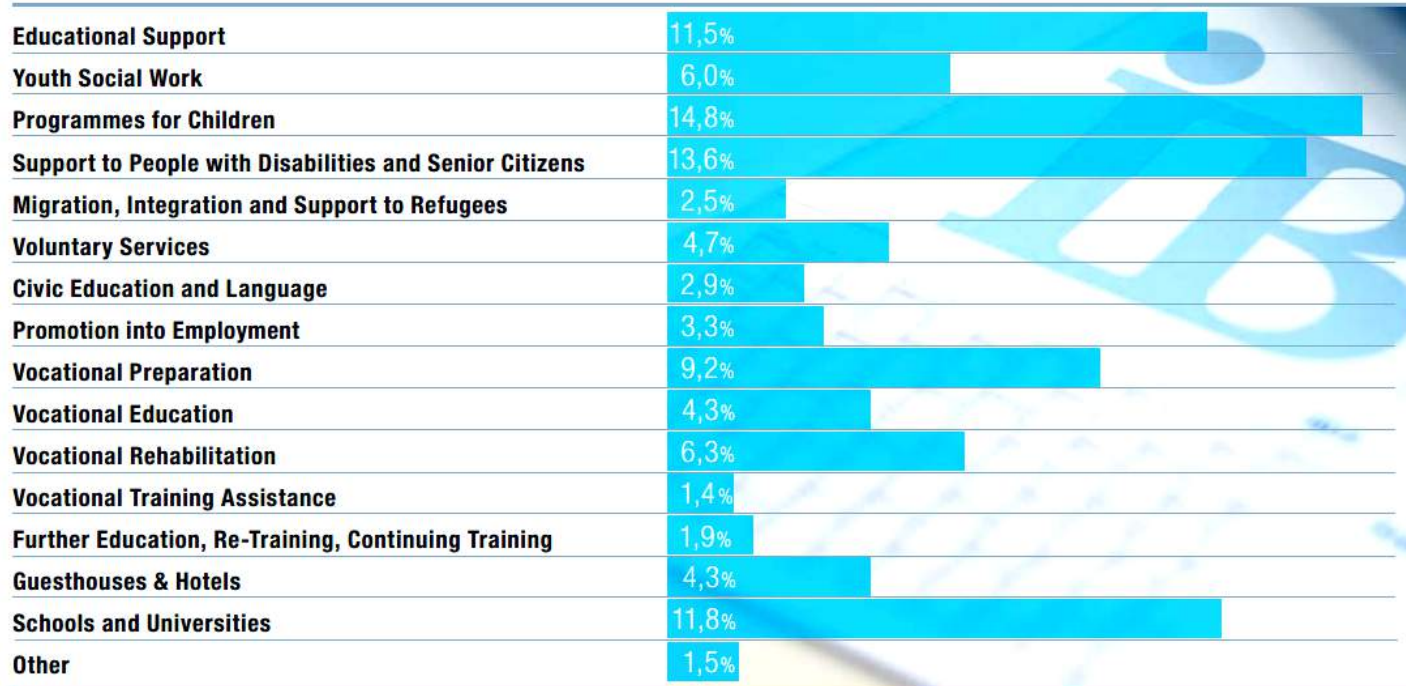

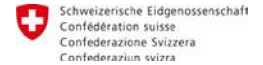
